MISSION

The Colonial Road Runners (CRR) awards one or more annual scholarships to student-athletes who best exemplify excellence in running, academics, volunteerism and overall citizenship. These individuals are selected from all candidates through a rigorous evaluation process. To be selected means the student-athletes have demonstrated not only a willingness to make the sacrifices necessary to excel in his or her running activities, but also strives toward excellence in all aspects of school and community endeavors. Earning these scholarships reflects on the outstanding character of the recipient and his or her family, and the impact they have made on our society.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The criteria for awarding the CRR scholarships are set by the CRR Scholarship Committee, and are subject to change.

◆ **Required:**

1. A runner, preferably a distance runner. (Race walkers will be considered if their accomplishments merit such.)
2. A CRR member since January 1 of year selected.

◆ **Very Important:**

1. Member of a running team.
2. Strives for excellence and is a competitive runner.
3. High academic achievements.
4. Volunteer activities, both in running and in community service.

◆ **Moderately Important:**

1. A resident of the local Williamsburg/Peninsula area.

◆ **Not Important:**

1. Financial need (this is a merit-based scholarship)
