Paul discussed the 2018 CRR scholarship application. In 2017 we only had 2 applicants' that met the requirement of being a CRR club member as of the January 1<sup>st</sup> cut-off date. In order to get more applicants a motion was made by Paul to remove the mandatory club member requirement. The motion was 2nd by Greg and all voted in favor of the change. Paul will update the 2018 application. Being a club member will not be mandatory but it may impact the amount of the award.
