Steve is in the process of taking pictures of the merchandise to be able to post them on the CRR website. He hopes to finish it by the end of the month, but he needs help with the layout, which Rick and Will agreed to provide. There was also agreement that it would be preferable to have CRR members model the merchandise.
- Ron Henn said that the finish line crew needs to replace/refurbish some of its equipment, e.g., bullhorn, clock stand, finish line stanchion plates. Ron will provide an inventory of needs at an upcoming meeting.
- Randy gave a brief financial report indicating that the CRR currently had a balance of approximately \$11,000.

4. New Business:

- Rick passed around an email from a marketing company representing Michelob Ultra. The company is interested in surveying running clubs to determine potential candidates for Michelob Ultra to sponsor. After a brief discussion there was agreement that Rick respond to the survey, as simply responding involved no commitment on the part of the CRR.
- Rick also passed around a sponsorship form for the CRR Queens Lake race to the Board members in an effort to stimulate sponsors for the race.
- Rick advised that in preparation for the Annual Meeting the Nominating Committee would be stood up. He informally polled Board members and Officers present if they would consider extending their terms for 2015-2016. All inidicated that they would.
- Rick solicited ideas for a speaker for the annual meeting. Terry McManus had suggested Chris Slowinski, and there was agreement that he would be a good candidate. Chris will be approached to speak.
- Rick indicated that he would renew the listing of upcoming races in the Gazette and Daily Press.
