1. Approved minutes from the last meeting as written.

2. Old Business:

- There was brief discussion of the Runner Friendly City initiative. The CRR needs a coordinator for this effort.

3. Committee and Club Updates:

- Greg also provided an update on the July 5K at Clara Byrd/Powhatan Creek trail to benefit the travel team. He sought information about race preparation checklists and a couple of members indicated they would send him some.

- Mike McDonald advised the Board he had been pressed into service as a bike leader for the Achievable Dream Half Marathon.

4. New Business:

-Rick stated that there was \$1905.63 available for this year's scholarships. The Board members reviewed and discussed the applications. There was unanimous approval to award three \$500 schoarships to Ben Wahls, Brian McManus, and Jason Menzies. Jim Goggin will handle publicity for the awardees, i.e., picture-taking for the Gazette.
